Canada Winter Games Selection Criteria

Eligibility

Canadian citizen or landed immigrant with permanent domicile or actual residence in PEI for at least 90 days prior to the opening of the Games and with membership in the Prince Edward Island Badminton Association, or a full time out-of-province student enrolled for the current academic year, prior to the year of the Games.

Selection

The selection of the Canada Winter Games Badminton Team to represent Prince Edward Island will be based on the following considerations:

- 1. Results in Round Robin Singles competitions within the Training Squad.
- 2. Results in Island and Off-Island tournaments in Singles, Doubles and Mixed Doubles.
- 3. Ability to perform well and demonstrate fitness against out-of-province opponents.
- 4. Results of fitness testing and demonstration of fitness in training.
- 5. Special strength in a particular event or in two events.
- 6. Observance of instructions and training requirements of the Canada Games Coach.

The team will be selected by the Coach and endorsed by the Canada Games Committee of the Prince Edward Island Badminton Association not later than the conclusion of the Final Trials, which are to be completed no later than mid-December prior to a Games and ratified by the Board of Directors of the Association prior to the end of December prior to a Games.

In the absence of any significant success in other competitions the team will be selected on the basis of the results in the Round Robin Singles competitions within the Training Squad. In the event of a tie for fifth place results in competition in Doubles and/or Mixed Doubles will be taken into account in making the selection.

Appeal

Badminton PEI's Appeal Process is available for any candidate for selection who is dissatisfied with the decision of the selectors.
